

# Camporee 2019 - Skills of Scouting

## Camp Brosig March 29<sup>th</sup>-31<sup>st</sup>, 2019

Iron Horse and Phoenix districts are coming together to host a weekend full of competition to test your Scouting skills. Patrols will compete in rank specific contests in archery, tomahawk throwing, fire building, first aid, pioneering, orienteering, and nature study. Troops will also be competing in the Grand Skills Relay. Scoutmasters will have an opportunity to demonstrate their skills in a specialized cook off. The event will culminate with a campfire and awards ceremony.

### Patrols:

Patrol Make up should be no more than 10 Scouts, the patrol will compete at the level of the highest-ranking member. There will be three classifications of patrols.

New Scout: Under one year in Scouting BSA and no member over the rank of Tenderfoot

Scout: More than one year less than four no member over the rank of Star

Senior Scouts: Any Scout in the patrol over the rank of Star
